GUIDELINES FOR THE 1987 SURVEY

The Prime Minister has seen the Chief Secretary's minute of 18 March, to which was attached draft guidelines for the 1987 Survey. The Chief Secretary also proposed that the new third year of the Survey should be calculated on the basis of an uplift factor of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent.

The Prime Minister is content, subject to the views of colleagues, both with the draft guidelines and the proposal for uplift of the new final year by  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent.
