The independents are afraid that without some minimum specified profit levels and agreed terms for distribution they will be exploited in individual negotiations between themselves and companies because of the sheer size and power of the ITV companies. The draft letter by the Home Secretary is a good one and supportive of the Independents' cause. It emphasises, inter alia, the need for fair terms, the option of approaching the OFT, and the readiness of the Government to consider legislation.
