ECONOMIC SUMMIT IN TORONTO


We need to decide arrangements to get you to the Economic Summit in Toronto. The Summit itself starts on Sunday, 19 June. Exactly when it will start that day remains uncertain, but there will certainly be a reception at 5 p.m. and a dinner that evening, with welcoming ceremonies earlier in the day.

It would be feasible for you to travel to Toronto on the Sunday if you leave London very early. But it would make a horribly long day by the time you got to bed after the dinner. I really don't recommend it.

The alternative would be to travel out to Toronto on Saturday, 18 June. You have the Welsh Conference that morning, but I am told that you will be back from that by early Saturday afternoon (we could always helicopter you). If we were to leave at about 1600-1630 on Saturday, we should be able to have you in Toronto by 1900 local time (about one in the morning English time). That would enable you to get a good night's rest in the hotel, and have the day free on Sunday for bilaterals as well as the welcoming ceremony/reception/dinner.
