I should be grateful for your agreement to the inclusion of the following support staff in the Delegation for the Economic Summit to be held in Toronto from 19-21 June.

a) 2 Conference Officers: Miss S M Waghorn Miss C Gibson

(One would travel onto Ottawa to finalise arrangements for that part of the visit).

- b) A Personal Assistant from Protocol Department to work for the Conference Officers prior to the Meeting and for advisers during the meeting.
- c) Mr C K Davies, Communications Co-ordinator, Cabinet Office, to look after all aspects of communications. 7 Communications Officers (this number includes 2 engineers and 2 officers who operate the communications on the RAF VC10).
