## ECONOMIC SUMMIT: PRIME MINISTER'S BILATERAL WITH THE ITALIAN PRIME MINISTER

I see from Ottawa telegram No. 366 that it is proposed that the Prime Minister should see Signor de Mita at 1800 on Saturday 18 June.

The Prime Minister will not have arrived in Toronto until 1530 local time and will presumably not be settled in her hotel until about 1630. A meeting with de Mita at 1800 local time is the equivalent of seeing him at midnight London time. I am not sure that that is very wise. Would it not be possible to find a time on the Sunday morning when neither the Prime Minister nor Signor de Mita are involved in the arrival ceremonies? I should be most grateful if you could look into this.
