W.-ARGENTINE RELATIONS
1. AS YOU SEE WE ARE IN FOR A CONTINUATION OF THE 'BACK BURNES AND MR RIDLEY WOULD RATHER DISCUSS ALL ITEMS OF RELATIONS WITH ARGENTINA OTHER THAN SOVEREIGNTY OVER THE FALKLAND ISLANDS BUT WILL BE PREPARED TO DISCUSS THIS ALSO, MITHOUT GOING FURTHER THAN WE HAVE DONE BEFORE. EVEN TO GO AS FAR WILL PROBABLY REQUIRE U TO MAKE A FURTHER ATTEMPT WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE BEFORE MR RIDLEY GOES TO BUENOS AIRES.

5. YOU SHOULD KNOW THAT THE LUNCH FOR CAVANDOLI WAS ALSO ATTENDED BY SIR RONALD ELLI'S, JAMES JOHNSON MR, DAVID MONTGOMERY AND HUNTER CHRISTIE. THERE WAS A GOOD DEAL OF CONVERSATION ABOUT FISHERIES IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC AND MR RIDLEY AND RON ELLI'S TALKED ABOUT ARGENTINE AIR FORCE REQUIREMENTS. ON FISHERIES I REPEATED STRONGLY WHAT I HAD SAID TO GUEVARA, THAT THE FIRST ESSENTIAL WAS TO CONTROL THE ACTIVITIES OF THIRD PARTIES FISHING IN THE AREA, PARTICULARLY TO CONSERVE AND RENEW FISH STOCKS AND ESSENTIAL WAS TO CONTROL THE ACTIVITIES OF THIRD PARTIES FISHING
IN THE AREA, PARTICULARLY TO CONSERVE AND RENEW FISH STOCKS AND
THAT THE BRITISH WIDE WOULD BE PERFECTLY WILLING TO BEGIN SUCH
CO-OPERATION IMMEDIATELY, WHILEST THE ARGENTINES WERE BLOCKING
THIS BY DEMANDING CONCESSIONS ON SOVEREIGNTY FIRST. THIS WAS
SUPPORTED BY ALL THOSE ON THE BRITISH SIDE, INCLUDING HUNTER
CHRISTIE WHO IN GENERAL MADE NO QUALIFICATIONS ABOUT SUPPORT FOR
ANGLO-ARGENTINE CO-OPERATION.
6. I HOPE THIS WILL BE USEFUL IN THE RUN UP TO MR RIDLEY'S
VISIT. WE ARE PRODUCING TALKING POINTS FOR HIM ON ALL ASPECTS
OF ANGLO-ARGENTINE RELATIONS AND CO OPERATION. THE EMPHASIS
FROM HIS SIDE WILL BE TO PLAY DOWN POLITICS, AND PARTICULARLY
SOVEREIGNTY, AND TO HIGHLIGHT TRADE AND ECONOMICS. YOU WILL
UNDOUBTEDLY BE UNDER PRESSURE FROM THE ARGENTINES TO DO EXACTLY
THE REVERSE.
