Mr Ridley visited the Geneva area privately between 9 and 12 September with his wife for a short holiday break and to do a little water colour painting.

Why the secrecy?

It is not normal to announce private ministerial holiday visits abroad.

(If asked) <u>Is it true that he met an Argentine Minister</u>/ Comodoro Cavandoli?

Comodoro Cavandoli appears to have been making a visit to a number of European countries, including Switzerland. He knows and contacted Mr Ridley. They met briefly on a personal basis.

What did they discuss: the Falkland Islands?

Mr and Mrs Ridley were on a private holiday. Mr Ridley held exploratory talks with Comodoro Cavandoli in New York last April. We hope to continue these exchanges but no dates have yet been fixed.
