"The Argentine Government has accepted a United Nations decision to postpone a debate on the future of the Falkland Islands – the sovereignty of which has been the subject of a long-running dispute between Argentina and Britain. As well as postponing the debate, the United Nations has also agreed to delay any further actions on the future of the Islands until next year. The BBC Latin America correspondent says an improvement in relations between Britain and Argentina has created a better atmosphere for talks, but he points out that the attitudes of the two governments still appear to rule out any early solution."
