- 1. Canadian Energy Policy. Canadian Energy Minister Lalonde outlined to a Parliamentary Committee today a number of changes in the first piece of legislation before Parliament to implement Canada's National Energy Program. The proposed changes would go far toward meeting our concerns about provisions that discriminate against US suppliers and that fail to compensate US oil companies in the event that the Canadian Government acquires certain of their assets. These changes result in large part from the US-Canadian consultation process set up during your Ottawa trip in March. (U)
- 2. Meeting With Yugoslav Ambassador. In advance of our reception of the Romanian Foreign Minister tomorrow, Yugoslav Ambassador Loncar visited me this afternoon. I impressed on him our strong support for non-aligned Yugoslavia's territorial integrity, sovereignty, and independence.

Loncar reiterated his Government's invitation to me to visit Yugoslavia as soon as my schedule permitted. (C)
