Canadian/Soviet Grain Agreement. The Canadian Foreign Minister has informed me that Canada will sign an agreement this evening with the Soviet Union for the sale of a total of 25 million tons of wheat and feedgrains to the USSR, and Cuba, over a five-year period. He asked that this be held very closely until a public announcement is made. I have informed only Jack Block. We do not have full details of the deal but we are told that the agreement will be on a "best efforts basis", meaning that the full level of the sale may not be attained.

The Foreign Minister reaffirmed Canada's commitment to a strong position on Poland and Afghanistan.
