

Consultations on the Hill about Habib Mission. Over the last two days, Phil Habib briefed key Congressmen and Senators on his mission.

All members of Congress were strongly supportive and offered to help. Habib thanked the House and Senator leaderships (and others) for their efforts to postpone action on the Syrian aid issue. (He telephoned Senator Proxmire yesterday in appreciation of the Senator's particular help on this matter.)

Habib expressed reservations about a resolution on the crisis advanced by Senator Kennedy, as well as a similar House resolution -- introduced yesterday by Congressmen Rosenthal and Derwinski--because these public declarations could complicate our task. (CONFIDENTIAL/EXDIS)

Walesa Visit to U.S. Our DCM in Warsaw was informed late today by a key Church advisor to Solidarity that Lech Walesa has accepted an invitation from the Copernicus Society (headed by Edward Piszek, President of Mrs. Paul's Kitchens) to visit the United States July 3-14. During the visit, he would receive the Freedom Medal of the City of Philadelphia from Mayor Green, whose office is aware of Walesa's plans. According to the Church advisor, Walesa has also asked to see me and I intend to see him. We have already established a liaison with Mayor Green's office on planning for the visit. (C)
