The Israeli Election-II. Though the Israeli election results show the public virtually split down the middle between the nation's two major groupings, it seems likely that Begin will be able to form another government with the support of the 13 seats won by the religious camp. Even if the Labor Alignment commands a one or two seat plurality after all the votes have been counted, Peres will find it difficult to offer the religious parties a better deal than the Likud. A Begin-led government, however, will still have only a tenuous majority, though he has managed to rule this past year under similar circumstances. (S)
