1. UNGA Adopts ASEAN Resolution on Kampuchea. The General Assembly in Plenary session approved a resolution proposed by ASEAN countries on "the Situation in Kampuchea" by a vote of 100 to 25 with 19 abstentions. The vote on a similar resolution last year was 97 to 23 with 22 abstentions. The resolution calls for withdrawal of all foreign troops from Kampuchea and selection of a new government by the people of Kampuchea. The vote was a major victory for ASEAN and the West, and a firm repudiation of Vietnam's aggression in Kampuchea. (C)

2. Foreign Assistance Authorization Bill. The Senate today adopted by 51 to 45 Senator Glenn's Amendment to the Foreign Assistance Authorization Bill which will require a cutoff of all assistance to India or Pakistan should either detonate a nuclear device. Following this, the Senate adopted Senator Helms' Amendment requiring a cutoff of aid to any non-nuclear country which detonates a nuclear device.
