1. Nicaragua. Walt Stoessel called in Nicaraguan Ambassador Cruz today to protest the treatment of an Embassy Marine Guard arrested in Nicaragua for an incident stemming from a fight. Walt termed the Nicaraguans' handling of the affair, particularly the display of the Marine to the local press, unpardonable and not befitting a responsible and serious government. After reviewing applicable sections of the Vienna Convention, Walt demanded the Marine's immediate release to the custody of our Charge d'Affaires. Ambassador Cruz regretted the way the Marine had been treated, said he had been told his government would resolve the situation and promised to communicate Walt's comments immediately to the ruling Junta. (C)

2. Dutch Support Spanish NATO Entry. Saturday morning Dutch Foreign Minister Van der Stoel told Spanish Foreign Minister Perez Llorca that the Dutch would positively support Spain's petition for NATO membership next week in Brussels. If so, Spain will present its letter requesting membership to NATO SYG Luns on Tuesday and Luns will warmly welcome the Spanish bid. NATO Ministers will formally sign a protocol of accession on December 10 in Brussels. Ratification by member governments is expected to take four to six months. (C).
