- 1. As you know, the International Committee of the Red Cross have offered their usual medical and humanitarian services in the Falkland Islands.
- 2. The ICRC are extremely sensitive about their neutral status and we should avoid any press comment suggesting that they have taken the UK side in the dispute: --
- As agreed, we should for the moment confine our statements to an acknowledgement that the ICRC have made the offer, which we welcome.
- I understand that the ICRC will make a statement this afternoon to the effect that they have contacted one of the parties involved and will be contacting the other.
