## FALKLANDS: IRISH GOVERNMENT STATEMENT

I attach a copy of the Irish statement issued today, which was also released by the Irish EC representative in Brussels, together with an earlier Irish statement issued on 2 May. Also attached is a draft press line, concocted by ECD(E) in consultation with other departments, which is being submitted. Prior to approval, I suggest that we use only paragraph one of the line to-take on the record, drawing on the rest as necessary unattributably.

Mr Pym was asked in the House this afternoon about the position of an EC Government on the Falklands dispute. He declined substantive comment because that Government had not formally communicated its views to HMG. In fact, he had just learnt of their views from agency reports.

Ukrep Brussels will have the same line to take. On a related issue, the Political Committee meeting in Brussels has ended. The Belgian Presidency is simply confirming that the meeting discussed the Falklands situation, without going into details of the discussion.

FALKLANDS: IRISH GOVERNMENT STATEMENT

 THE IRISH GOVERNMENT ISSUED THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT ABOUT THE FALKLANDS CRISIS AFTER A CABINET MEETING YESTERDAY, 2 MAY.

BEGINS

THE GOVERNMENT ARE SERIOUSLY CONCERNED AT THE ESCALATING MILITARY SITUATION IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC.

FROM THE OUTSET OF THE FALKLANDS CRISIS, THE POLICY OF THE IRISH GOVERNMENT, BOTH AT THE UNITED NATIONS AND WITHIN THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY, HAS BEEN DIRECTED TO PREVENTING A WIDER CONFLICT AND PROMOTING A NEGOTIATED, HONOURABLE SETTLEMENT BY DIPLOMATIC MEANS.

AN ADEQUATE FRAMEWORK ALREADY EXISTS WITHIN WHICH SUCH A SETTLEMENT CAN BE ACHIEVED IF THE PARTIES DEMONSTRATE THE POLITICAL WILL TO DO SO.

IT IS IMPORTANT, THEREFORE, THAT THE POSSIBILITIES OFFERED BY THE UNITED NATIONS SHOULD BE FULLY EXPLOITED AND FURTHER MILITARY ESCALATION WHICH WOULD ONLY MAKE NEGOTIATIONS ALL THE MORE DIFFICULT AVOIDED. IRELAND IS READY TO HELP IN ANY WAY IT CAN, THROUGH ITS CURRENT MEMBERSHIP OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL, TO ADVANCE A DIPLOMATIC SOLUTION.

THE GOVERNMENT WISH TO RE-AFFIRM IRELAND'S TRADITIONAL ROLE OF NEUTRALITY IN RELATION TO ARMED CONFLICTS.
