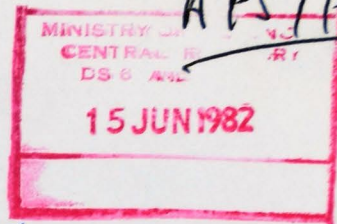

- c. Review of the Papal visit.
- d. Eyewitness account of 4 Skyhawks being shot down.
- e. Sports report.
- f. A feature on the more blatant deceit and untruths that have appeared recently in the Argentine media.

Reception/Feedback

- 4. Monitoring reports from Ascencion have now confirmed that Argentine jamming is also being attempted during the morning broadcast. As with their efforts in the evening, the effect of this jamming is very limited and should not unduly interfere with reception in the Falklands.
- 5. This is another positive indication that RA del S broadcasts are proving effective.
