Summary of Programme 47 - 15 Jun 82

General

1. The station has now ceased its morning broadcast between 0930 - 1030 hrs A. It was felt that, in the circumstances since the Argentine surrender on the Falkland Islands, the 3 hour evening broadcast would give sufficient coverage.

3. The principal features were:

- a. Military situation.
- b. Transcript of the report by Max Hastings on entering Port Stanley.
- c. World reaction to the Argentine surrender.
- d. Lessons from the war for Argentina.
- e. Falklands Islands economic opportunities, based on an article by Patrick Cosgrove.
