Your Correspondence Section have sent an acknowledgement and asked us to send a fuller reply. The President of the KNO is Dr Jagjit Singh Chauhan, who claims to lead a Khalistan "Government-in-exile", and whose inflammatory remarks to the British press are now being investigated by the police, following complaints by the Indian Government. The letter to the Prime Minister is signed by an associate of Chauhan, Mr Mehtab Singh, but the address on the letter heading is that of Dr Chauhan's private residence. I enclose a copy of a KNO press release dated 7 June, also signed by Mehtab Singh, announcing a reward of £50,000 "to anyone who brings Prime Minister Mrs Indira Gandhi and her son, Rajiv Gandhi, dead or alive at Golden Temple, Amritsar". In the circumstances, we think it would be inappropriate to reply to Mr Mehtab Singh's letter of 18 June. Now that Dr Chauhan has set himself up as the leader of a so-called "Government-in-exile" here, you may wish to ask your Correspondence Section to ensure that any further communications from Chauhan or from the KNO do not receive an acknowledgement. RE: MASSACRE AT GOLDEN TEMPLE AMRITSAR

We are disturbed at the anxiety expressed to her Majesty's Government by Mrs Indra Ghandi over the setting up by the Sikhs of a Khalistan Government in exile in London headed by Dr Jagjit Singh Chohan.

Our organisation like other Sikh organisations in this country, supports this Government and we see nothing wrong in the set up thereof - this is a democratic country and every individual and organisation has the right to express his or her view freely.

You can be rest assured that while the Sikhs, including British Sikhs, continue to protest at the storming of their holiest shrine and at the mass murder of innocent men, women and children, this will be done peacefully as was proved at the 80,000 strong march last Sunday.

The massacre of innocent people will never be forgiven by the Sikh nation. As a direct response to this, a Khalistan Government in exile was set up and Mrs Ghandi should understand that both the political and geographical map of her country must now change, whether she accepts it or not.

The use of the National Army to invade religious and sacred shrines belonging to a minority community is wholly unacceptable in a civilised society. It is therefore ironical that Mrs Ghandi should complain to your Government over the natural reaction of the Sikhs in this country of the horrors committed by her army in total secrecy.

Perhaps you would be good enough to lodge a formal protest to the Indian Government on behalf of the British Sikhs on the storming of their holiest shrine and the massacre of innocent people therein. Our estimate is that about 10,000 people have been killed although the official Government announcement is about 1,000!
