SIKH EXTREMISTS: DAMAGE TO INDO-BRITISH RELATIONS


The Prime Minister is extremely concerned by the situation reported in the Foreign Secretary's minute of 2 December on this subject. I have reported to her the information on the three people named in the Foreign Secretary's minute given to me by Nigel Pantling. She is relieved to hear of the decision to refuse the request for registration under the 1981 Nationality Act from the Kashmiri.

The Prime Minister is unable to understand the delay in submitting recommendations on the question of control of foreign political activists generally. She wishes these to come forward urgently.

I am copying this letter to Len Appleyard (FCO) as well as to Private Secretaries of other members of OD.
