The Home Secretary may raise the question of giving a full British passport to Eric Ho, as a means of getting him on to the Joint Liaison Group. He is not keen on this, mainly on the grounds that he has statutory powers and should not be directed. But there can be no doubt that Mr Ho is a suitable person, and the foreign policy considerations are very strong.

Finally and if there is time you might enquire in confidence how the Home Secretary is getting on with Dikko's request for asylum and when a decision can be expected.
