PRIME MINISTER

The proposal is;

- (i) to dock the aid programme to India by £25 million this year (if the Westlands order finally collapses);
- (ii) not necessarily to reinstate it next year;
- (iii) to make clear that this is the inevitable result of the Indians' own actions;
- (iv) to use the money for unspecified new bids, including Indonesia.

Agree this, but seek a more <u>specific</u> commitment from the Foreign Secretary on how to use the £25 million: e.g. for ATP?
