INDIA: WESTLAND HELICOPTERS

The Prime Minister has considered the Foreign Secretary's minute of 13 May on this subject. She is broadly content with the proposals set out in it but would like to have a clearer picture of precisely how the £25 million which would be available if the Westland contract is finally lost would be allocated. In particular, she would wish to know whether the Foreign Secretary envisages using all or some of it for ATP. She would be grateful if the Foreign Secretary could set out his intentions in more detail.
