The Prime Minister will be met at the foot of the aircraft steps in Montreal before proceeding by car to a meeting.

The Canadian Government will escort Mr Thatcher during YMX transit.

Press will also attend a press conference during YMX transit.

All other passengers will remain in the terminal building at YMX. Refreshments will be provided by the Canadian Government for transit pax.

The Canadian Government has waived customs and immigration procedures for the press party at Montreal.

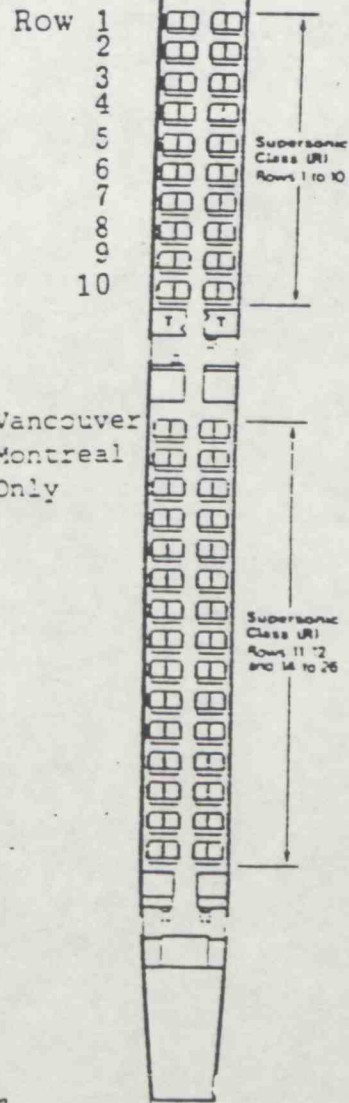

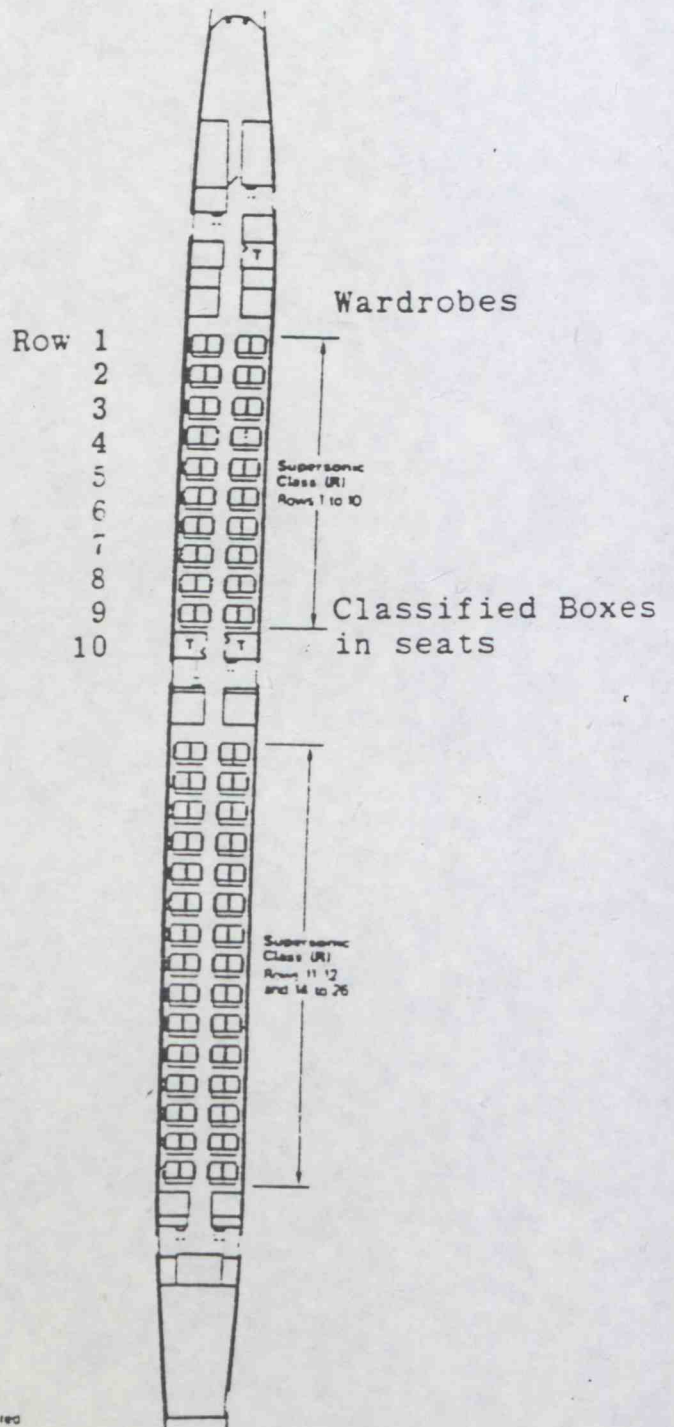

ADVANCE ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE
VISIT OF THE PRIME MINISTER

(This paper is issued for the benefit of those travelling to give advance information on travel documents, health requirements, clothing, climate etc.)

1. DETAILS OF VISIT

The Prime Minister, Mr Thatcher and accompanying party will travel in a British Airways Concorde as follows (all times local):-

2. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

Each member of the party must be in possession of a valid passport. Visas are not required for Canada.

3. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

There are no obligatory health requirements for Canada.

4. CLIMATE AND CLOTHING

a) Average minimum and maximum temperatures for mid July in Vancouver are:-

55°F	-	72°F


The weather is variable and it could rain. Mackintoshes should be brought. When touring EXPO it may be hot (up to 80°F) inside the Pavilions and humid also.

b) The visit to the Ballet and Prime Minister's Reception afterwards will be black tie/long dress.

5. BAGGAGE

The normal baggage entitlement on Concorde is two pieces of checked baggage, the dimensions of which, when added together, do not exceed 62" (158 cms) for each piece, neither to exceed 70 lbs (32 kgs) in weight.

Additionally, all passengers are allowed a garment bag (one suit size) and one piece of cabin baggage, the dimensions of which, when added together, do not exceed 45" (114 cms), nor weigh more than 5 kgs.
