1. We have been told by the Police that the New Zealand High Commissioner and his family (wife and one child) were held up at knife-point by three intruders in his Residence, 43 Chelsea Square, at about 0145 hours on 5 May.

- 2. We understand that the Chubb alarm had been switched off inadvertently, as a result of which the alarm could not be activated. The intruders left taking with them jewels, money and credit cards. No injuries were suffered other than the High Commissioner who has a small cut to his face.
- 3. Chelsea Police are with him now. The family are very shaken and we shall hear more details during the course of the day.
- 4. You have indicated that the Secretary of State intends to write to the High Commissioner.
