On 14 June the House of Commons Environment Committee published its report on air pollution. The report was moderate in tone and not unhelpful - particularly in the negotiations on the EC large combustion plants directive. There is much that is positive that can be said in the Government's response.

Subject to colleagues' views, I propose to publish the Government's reply in the form of a White Paper, aiming for the late autumn, and certainly within six months of the report. I shall ensure that colleagues are fully consulted on the terms of the reply.
