## NUCLEAR LEVY AND CLIMATIC CHANGE

Norman Lamont and Nicholas Ridley have recently been in correspondence with Cecil Parkinson on the above subject. They have suggested that the nuclear levy, rather than being shared out on a per KWh basis over all fossil fuel stations, should be shared out on CO<sub>2</sub> weighted-KWh basis.

Calculations carried out by myself and by the Treasury with the following assumptions:

- fossil fuel electricity at 3.5p/KWh
- nuclear electricity at 5p/KWh, and
- capacity split nuclear 20%/fossil fuel 80%

show that the nuclear levy on a coal fired station would be 0.3p/KWh and on a combined cycle gas turbine about 0.15p/KWh.

The difference in absolute terms seems small, however, in merit order terms, it is significant.

DEn are dismissive of the idea, however, I believe it bears detailed study.
