SAVING THE OZONE LAYER CONFERENCE: 5 MARCH


The top copy of your speech for Sunday is in the folder.

Also attached is a note from the Press Office on the detailed programme. In the morning, you will need to depart from here at 0940 in order to be at the Queen Elizabeth II Centre for the 0945 start.

You wanted scientists to attend. Sir John Mason and Professor Knill will definitely be there on Sunday. Sir George Porter hopes to (and will definitely come to the Monday and Tuesday sessions). Sir Francis Tombs has been invited. DoE have made arrangements for them to be looked after at the Ministerial lunch and they have front row seats with the DoE's Chief Scientist. DoE have also invited to the evening reception about 20 British scientists who are either Fellows of the Royal Society or were suggested by Professor Knill as senior experts in the natural environment field. The NERC report 'Our Future World', will also be distributed at the conference. Your copy is in the folder. Bernard has briefed the Sunday Lobby so it should get off to a good start.

For the reception in the evening, at which Mr Thatcher will accompany you, you will want to leave here to walk through to the Durbar Court at 1820 to be ready to head the receiving line. DoE are arranging for this to be the main Heads of Missions only. There should then be a short gap before the rest of the delegates all come in.
