## Secretary of State

After the Prime Minister had approved the Order-in-Council being put forward some other points were raised:

- collection of information by satellite, SR71 or U2 which she regarded as of very great importance.. I told her action was in hand. She said if we did not make progress she was very ready to speak to President Reagan. A/CDS has spoken to our intelligence people who are in touch with the US;
- I mentioned to her the problem of strategic discussions in the media as being possibly helpful to the Argentines. She is going to ask Mr Whitelaw to speak to Mr George Howard and Lord Thompson and to look at the problems as a whole. I have got the Secretary of the D-Notice Committee looking at the matter as well. She may speak on the matter in public herself:
- it is likely that a note will issue tomorrow to Ministers instructing Whitehall as a whole to get geared-up;
- it is likely that there will be a small inner group of Ministers to oversee matters and in effect a 2-tier arrangement. She is very concerned about security and leakage of plans;
- more needs to be done on the PR and psychological front. It is likely that instructions will be issued to the FCO;
