INFORMING BDLS WASHINGTON

1. General Boam called me from Washington at 1820A this evening.
2. He appreciated we were busy but he thought it was essential for him to be kept fully in the picture as to what was going on. It would then be most useful if we could indicate what facts he was at liberty to divulge to the Americans. General Boam tries to keep the Ambassador informed and is trying to set up a comprehensive briefing for Vice President Bush.
3. I said we would do our best in arranging something to meet his requirements. He said it would be useful if he could have a first instalment overnight ready for use by him by mid-morning local time tomorrow, 6 April 1982.
4. It seems to me that such a service might be very useful to other key (or perhaps all) DAs.
