Conference on Security and Co-operation in Europe

The Prime Minister has seen the minute of 23 June by the Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary.

Subject to the views of other OD colleagues, she agrees with Sir Geoffrey Howe's recommendations, namely that we should accept the proposal tabled by Spain and that, in doing so, we should seek agreement of all on the Western side that this represents our final position and that there can be no further concessions.
