Afghanistan

Lord Cranborne has been in touch with the Political Office here to ask whether the Prime Minister would agree to a brief meeting with Engineer Izaak Ses-Haq. Apparently, Ses-Haq is Masoud's No.2 in the Panchu Valley. Lord Cranborne recalls that the Prime Minister did meet Commander Masoud when he was in England.

I should be grateful for urgent advice. Apparently, Ses-Haq is in London only this week, and Lord Cranborne wants him to see the Prime Minister after Questions on Tuesday or Thursday.

He wondered whether the Prime Minister might agree to "shake the hand" of Engineer Izaak Ses-Haq. She did meet Commander Massud when he was in England - I think 2 summers ago - at the House of Commons after Questions.

Apparently Ses-Haq is Massud's number two in the Panchu Valley.

He is in London this week. Would there be any chance of him seeing the PM after Questions? The contact I have been given is Mr Tim Cooper of the Afghan Support Committee - 379-7218, but Robert Cranborne would, of course, bring him along.
