SUMMARY

1. GREEK GOVERNMENT PRESENT HMPS SETTLEMENT AS A TRIUMPH FOR GREEK DIPLOMACY. THE OPPOSHITION ATTACK PAPANDREOU FOR SETTLING FOR LESS THAN THE ORIGINAL COMMISSION PROPOSALS. THE PRESS DIVIDE ON PARTY LINES.

DETAIL

- 2. THE GREEK MINNISTER FOR EC AFFAIRS, PANGALOS, SPEAKING TO JOURNALISTS ON HIS RETURN FROM BRUSSELS ON 31 MARCH, PRESENTED THE SETTLEMENT ON HIMPS AS A DEAL WHICH WOULD GIVE GREECE A FIRM COMMITMENT TO RECEIVE AT LEAST 2 BILLION ECU OVER 7 YEARS AND AS REPRESENTING A TRIJUMPH FOR GREEK DIPLOMACY AND PAPANDREOU PERSONALLY.
- 3. PANGALOS ALSO EMPHASISED THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE SETTLEMENT AS REPRESENTING AN UNPRECEDENTED TRANSFER OF RESOURCES FROM THE NORTH TO THE SOUTH WHITHIN THE COMMUNITY. THE GREEK GOVERNMENT REGARDED THE DEAL AS A FAMIR SETTLEMENT TO OFFSET THE ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL COSTS OF ENLARGEMENT, BUT THEY DID NOT REGARD HET AS A FINAL SETTLEMENT OF THE GREEK MEMORANDUM.
- 4. THE GREEK OPPOSHITHON LEADER, MITSOTAKHS, HAS HISSUED A STATEMENT CLAHMING THAT GREECE HAD COME OFF BADLY BY THE SETTLEMENT AND CHARGING PAPANDREOU WITH MISHANDLING THE WHOLE HISSUE. MITSOTAKHS ATTACKED PAPANDREOU FOR ACCEPTING A DEAL WORTH LESS THAN THE ORIGINAL DELORS PROPOSAL (IN.E. A TOTAL OF 6.6 BILLHON ECU AS OPPOSED TO 7.7 BILLHON ECU) AND CLAHMED THAT GREECE'S REAL SHARE OF NEW MONEY (0.8 BILLHON ECU) WAS SUBSTANTHALLY LESS THAN THE 2.5 BILLHON ECU ENVISAGED UNDER THE ORIGINAL COMMISSION PROPOSALS.
- 5. THE GREEK PRESS HAVE DIVIDED ON PREDICTABLE PARTY LINES SIN SUPPORT OF OR AGAINST THE DEALTED

6. WOULD JUDGE THAT PAPANDREOU HS WELL PLEASED WITH THE OVERALL DEAL WHICH LOOKS ELECTORALLY PRESENTABLE. MITSOTAKHS' ATTACK DOES NOT SEEM WELL FOUNDED. THIS ASSESSMENT WAS SUPPORTED, IN CONVERSATION WITH A MEMBER OF MY STAFF OVER THE WEEKEND, BY THE FOREIGN MINISTER'S PRIVATE SECRETARY WHO EXPRESSED RELIEF THAT THE ISSUE HAD BEEN SETTLED SO QUICKLY ON TERMS WHICH GREECE HAD HAD LITTLE DIFFICULTY IN ACCEPTING.
