AND DESIRE TO DO EVERYTHING POSSIBLE TO MAINTAIN AND FURTHER ENHANCE THE VERY CLOSE RELATIONS BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES. NEEDLESS TO SAY, I RECIPROCATE YOUR FEELINGS AND WILL CONTINUE, ON MY PART, TO DO ALL I CAN TO PRESERVE AND STRENGTHEN THE VERY STRONG TIES WHICH HAPPILY BIND US.

MY GOVERNMENT ACCEPTS THE TERMS OF AGREEMENT AS
INCORPORATED IN THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING, AND IS
READY TO SIGN THIS WHENEVER IT IS CONVENIENT FOR YOUR
GOVERNMENT.
