Dear Charles, well in to send the attached recession of so, I will alert Ex-King Constantine's Son Philip Rose

As you know, the Prime Minister and the Foreign Secretary have agreed that Prince Paul of The Hellenes should attend Sandhurst and follow a military career (presumably with the British Army).

It is clearly recognised that this decision is likely to provoke a negative response from the Greeks. We have therefore addressed ourselves to the problem of how best the news should be presented. The Foreign Secretary considers that a Prime Ministerial message to Papandreou would be most appropriate.

The Ambassador in Athens advises that he should deliver the message personally to Papandreou or his Diplomatic Adviser, taking such necessary supportive action with the President's Office as seems necessary on the day. Since Mr Thomas is currently in the UK, delivery could not be made until after his return on 18 December.
