Dear Mr. Secretary-General, I acknowledge receipt of your letter of 29 March, 1986 with which you enclosed the document entitled 'Draft Framework Agreement : - 1-lay A inaltached folder. I should like to assure you that we are committed to a just and lasting solution of the Cyprus problem as a matter of urgency. It is precisely because of that commitment that we believe that, before the Greek Cypriot side expresses its views on the contents of the 'Draft Framework Agreement' you have presented, it is necessary that there be agreement on the basic issues of the Cyprus problem as a matter of priority. For this reason I request you to adopt one of two alternative procedures: I. To convene an International Conference in respect of the international aspects of the Cyprus problem, namely, 1. Withdrawal of the Turkish forces of occupation and settlers; and 2. Effective international guarantees. II. In the event that the holding of such an International Conference proves impossible, to convene a High Level Meeting to deal with the following matters, namely, 1. Withdrawal of the Turkish forces of occupation and settlers; 12
