MY TELNO 929: CYPRUS SUMMARY

1. SECRETARY-GENERAL HAS A VERY DIFFICULT TIME WITH PRESIDENT KYPRHANOU.

- 2. UNDER SECRETARY GENERAL GOULDING (WHO SHOULD NOT BE MENTHONED BY NAME) BRINEFED US THIS EVENING ON THE SECRETARY GENERAL'S TWO MEETINGS TODAY (26 SEPTEMBER) WINTH KYPRIMANOU.
- 3. KYPRHANOU HAD MADE INT CLEAR THAT THE GREEK CYPRHOTS WOULD NOT NOW OR EVER ACCEPT THE DRAFT FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT AS HIT STOOD. THE FURTHEST THEY COULD GO WOULD BE TO PUT INT ON ONE SINDE WHILE "MEANINGFUL" HIGH LEVEL NEGOTHATHONS TOOK PLACE ON THE THREE SUBJECTS (WETHDRAWALE, GUARANTEES AND 3 FREEDOMS). HE PROGRESS WAS ACHIEVED ON THESE AT WOULD BE POSSABLE TO RETURN TO THE CONSTITU-THIONAL AND TERRINTORMAL QUESTMONS AN THE DRAFT FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT. 4. KYPRHANOU HAD SAND THAT THE GREEK CYPRINOTS WOULD PROBABLY GO TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND WOULD PROPOSE UNDER ARTHICLE 96 OF THE CHARTER THAT THE HCJ BE ASKED TO GAVE AN ADVASORY OPHIRMON ON VARHOUS ASPECTS OF THE CYPRUS PROBLEM. (GOULDHING COMMENTED THAT HE HAD THE IMPRESSMON THAT THUS WAS INTENDED AS A KILIND OF THREAT, THOUGH HE AGREED WITH US THAT INT WAS ALMOST BOUND TO BACKFIRE). KYPRINANOU HAD BANGED ON A LOT ABOUT THE NON-ALEGNED SUMMEDT HEN HARARE AND CLAHMED THAT WORLD PUBLISC OPENION WAS MOVING IN THE GREEK CYPRISOTS' FAVOUR. HE HAD SAND THAT THERE WERE ONLY TWO WAYS FORWARD:
- (A) AN MINTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE (WHICH HE DESCRIBED OR GINALLY AS A CYPRIOT INDEA TAKEN UP BY THE SOVIETS)
- (B) A HUGH LEVEL MEETING.
- 4. AFTER SEVERAL HOURS OF THES SORT OF THEMS THE SECRETARY-GENERAL FEMALLY ALLOWED HEMSELF TO CONCEDE THAT HE THES WAS HOW KYPRHANOU WANTED HET HE WOULD CONSULT THE SECURETY COUNCIDE AND LET HEM KNOW WHAT THE FEELING WAS ABOUT AN HINTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE. HE MADE HET CLEARS, HOWEVER, THAT HES PERSONAL PREFERENCE WAS VERY MUCH FOR A HAGH LEVEL MEETING THOUGH HE WOULD STIML HAVE TO PERSUADE THE OTHER SIDE TO ATTEND HET.

THE SECRETARMAT ARE PUTTING OUT A BLAND STATEMENT TO THE PRESS SAYING THAT THE SECRETARY GENERAL'S MEETING WATH KYPRIPANOU HAD PROVIDED A USEFUL OPPORTUNARTY TO REVIEW THE SITUATION AND TO EXPLORE WAYS OF MOVING AHEAD IN HIS EFFORTS ON EXERCISE OF HIS MISSION OF GOOD OFFICES. PRINATELY, THOUGH, GOULDING DESCRIBED THE SITUATION AND THE ATMOSPHERE AS BAD AND SAID THAT THE MEETINGS HAD BEEN 'UNSPEAKABLE'.
