Anglo-French Summit: Prime Minister's Briefing Meeting,
5 pm Thursday, 20 November

I understand that it has been agreed that the Prime Minister should be accompanied to the Anglo-French Summit by the Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary, the Secretary of State for Defence, the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry and the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food; and that it has also been agreed that each Minister should be accompanied by a maximum of two officials, including a Private Secretary, except that the Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary will be accompanied by the Political and Economic Directors (Mr Braithwaite and Mr Thomas) in addition to his Private Secretary.
