1. SUMMARY

WIDESPREAD AND FAVOURABLE COVERAGE. CONSENSUS THAT PROBLEMS OVER TERRORISM, LAMB AND FALKLANDS WERE ECLIPSED BY COMMON APPROACH ON NUCLEAR ARMS CONTROL MISSUES.

- 2. THE SUMMANT WAS FULLY REPORTED ON FRENCH TV NEWS AND AN THE FRENCH PRESS, THOUGH MAINLY ON ANSIDE PAGES. THE GENERAL EMPHASIS WAS ON A NEW PERIOD OF HARMONY ON ANGLO-FRENCH RELATIONS, LARGELY ATTRIBUTABLE TO AGREEMENT ON STRATEGIC USSUES. MATTERRAND'S COMMENT THAT OF THE AMERICANS WERE AGAIN TO GO AS FAR AS THEY HAD AT REYKJAVIK, THERE WOULD NEED TO BE LONG AND DEEP CONSULTATION BEFOREHAND, WAS WADELY REPORTED. THE PRIME MANISTER WAS SEEN AS HAVING PLEADED NOT ONLY FOR BRATAIN BUT FOR EUROPE DURING HER TALKS IN CAMP DAVID. ONE TV NEWS BULLETIN CONCLUDED THAT THE BRATISH HAD DECADED TO SET THE SYRVAN AFFAIR ON ONE SADE ON ORDER TO WORK WATH FRANCE ON THE VATAL DISARMAMENT OSSUES, AND THIS THEME WAS ECHOED ON THE WASTEN PRESS.
- 3. TELEVISION CARRIED SCENES OF BOTH MATTERRAND AND CHARAC WATH THE PM. FOR ONCE. NO COMMENTATOR WAS ABLE TO DETECT ANY SERIOUS THE PROGRAMME WAS NOTED.
- 4. THE MEDIA NOTED CONTINUING DESAGREEMENTS OVER LAMB AND
 FALKLANDS. MATTERRAND'S COMMENT THAT AGRICULTURAL MINISTERS WOULD
 HAVE TO KEEP TALKING ABOUT LAMB WAS CONTRASTED WITH THE PM'S HOPE
 THAT LAMB CONSIGNMENTS WOULD NO LONGER BE INTERFERED WITH.

 5. ON TERRORISM, ONLY LE FIGARO RECORDED THE PM'S THANKS FOR FRENCH
 HELP ON DEALING WITH IRRISH TERRORISTS. BUT MOST NOTED BRITISH
 SATISFACTION WITH THE LEVEL OF EUROPEAN CO-OPERATION, BALANCED BY
 THE PM'S PLEA FOR COUNTRIES NOT TO UNDERCUT EACH OTHER.

6. COMMENT AN LE MONDE CONTRASTED THE WARMTH OF THAS SUMMENT WATH THE DAFFICULTIES OF THE LAST. DASAGREEMENTS OVER LAMB, SYRVA, ETC WERE OVER-SHADOWED BY THE NEED TO DRAW TOGETHER AFTER REYKJAVIK. LES ECHOS (BUSINESS DAILY) COMMENTED THAT THE SUMMENT HAD BEEN A GOOD THANG FOR EUROPE AN SO FAR AS AT HAD DEMONSTRATED THAT AF EUROPEANS WANTED TO BE SURE OF THEAR FUTURE AND THEAR DEFENCE, THEY HAD TO TAKE THE RESPONSABILITY FOR THEMSELVES.
