#### SUMMARY

1. SHOWN FICANCE OF ELECTION RESULTS FOR EACH PARTY. COALITION NEGOTHAT-IONS ON NEW CABINET AND STATEMENT OF GOVERNMENT POLICY ARE LHKELY TO BE TRACKY.

### DETAIL

2. THE PARTIES ARE MEETING SEPARATELY TO ASSESS YESTERDAY'S ELECTION RESULTS. FOR THE CDU/CSU, THE MAIN THING IS THAT THEY WON, AS THEY WERE EXPECTED TO DO ALL ALONG. BUT THEY HAVE BEEN CHASTENED AT GAINING A PERCENTAGE OF VOTES WHICH WAS THEIR LOWEST SINCE 1949, ALBEHT ONLY MARGINALLY LOWER THAN IN 1972 AND 1980, AND TO THIS EXTENT A CONTINUATION OF THEIR OSCILLATION UP AND DOWN AT EVERY ELECTION OVER THE LAST 30 YEARS. THIS TIME THEY WERE HIT HARD BY THE LOW TURNOUT, THE LOWEST SHNCE 1949, IN THE FRG'S FIRST-EVER WINTER ELECTION. FIRST ANALYSIS INDICATES THAT SOME 900,000 CDU/CSU SUPPORTERS STAYED AT HOME. THEY ALSO POLLED BADLY IN THEIR TRADIT-HONALLY STRONG RURAL AREAS, WHERE MANY FARMERS EVIDENTLY VOTED FOR OTHER PARTHES OR NOT AT ALL.

- 3. AT COU HO SPOKESMEN ARE ALSO BLAMMIG STRAUSS FOR THE UNION'S RELATINELY POOR SHOWING. THEY CRITICISE HIM FOR PROCLAIMING DURING THE CAMPAIGN THAT THE ELECTION WAS ALREADY WON, THEREBY ENCOURAGING UNION SUPPORTERS TO THINK THEY NEED NOT BOTHER TO VOTE, AND FOR ATTACKING GENSCHER'S CONDUCT OF FOREIGN POLICY. MANY NEWSPAPERS AGREE THAT STRAUSS SHARES THE BLAME, THOUGH ADDING THAT HT SUHTS THE CDU TO CAST HIM AS THE SCAPEGOAT, AS "IT OBY-OUSLY DOES.
- 4. THIS DIAGNOSIS IS NOT SHARED IN MUNICH. IN A SOUR-TEMPERED APPEARANCE ON TV ON ELECTION NIGHT, STRAUSS ARGUED THAT THE UNION HAD LOST VOTES BECAUSE AT HAD NOT PRESENTED SUFFICHENTLY CLEAR AND ROBUST POLICIES (REMARKS GREETED WITH HOOTS OF DERISHON BY THOSE WATCHING AT CDU HQ IN BONN). THE LOSSES, STRAUSS SAID, WERE NOT THE CSU'S FAULT: THE CSU HAD LOST LESS GROUND PROPORTIONATELY IN BAVARIA THAN THE COU DIO AN THE OTHER LAENDER.
- 5. THE SPD HAVE LITTLE TO BE PROUD OF. THEIR SHARE OF THE VOTE WAS THE IR LOWEST SINCE 1961, CONTINUING THE PARTY'S DOWNWARD TREND SANCE BRANDT'S VICTORY IN 1972. THEY LOST SOME 650,000 VOTES TO THE GREENS, AND IN MAJOR CITIES OUTSIDE THE RUHR WERE BETWEEN 6 AND 8

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PER CENT DOWN ON 1993. BUT BECAUSE THEY WERE FEARWING THE WORST, THE FARST REACTION TO THE RESULTS WAS ONE OF RELIEF. THE WARM RECEPTION ACCORDED TO RAU AT SPD HQ ON ELECTION WIGHT MADE HIM SEEM ALMOST LIKE A CONQUERING HERO. CERTAINLY HE TRIED HIS HARDEST: WE HIS NORTH RHINE-WESTPHALMAN HOMELAND HE EVEN INCREASED THE SPD'S VOTE BY 0.9 PER CENT COMPARED WITH 1983. HIS POSITION AS A VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE PARTY (AND A POTENTHAL SUCCESSOR TO BRANDT IN DUE COURSE) LOOKS SECURE.

- 6. THE FDP ARE VERY PLEASED. THEY FOUGHT AN HATELLINGENT AND WELL-FOCUSSED CAMPANGN. THANKS TO STRAUSS, THEY WERE ABLE TO MAKE THE MOST OF GENSCHER'S POSHTHON AS THE GUARDHAN OF OSTPOLINTHK AND DETENTE, AND TOOK BOO, DOO VOTES OFF THE CDU/CSU AS A RESULT. MANY NEWSPAPERS TODAY SEE GENSCHER AS THE REAL WHINER OF THE ELECTHONS.
- 7. THE GREENS HAD HARBOURED HOPES OF REACHING 10 PER CENT AND OVERTAKING THE FDP. THEM FAMILIRE TO DO ENTHER OF THESE THINGS SHOULD NOT DISGUISE THE FACT THAT THEM GAINS WERE PROPORTIONATELY THE LARGEST OF ANY PARTY. THEY WENT OVER 10 PER CENT ON THREE LAENDER, REACHING 14.5 PER CENT ON BREMEN. THEY WHILL HAVE MORE WENGHT TO THROW ABOUT ON THE NEXT BUNDESTAG: THEY HAVE ALREADY ANNOUNCED THAT THEY WILL BE SEEKING MORE EQUITABLE REPRESENTATION ON THE PARLHAMMENTARY COMMITTEES, AND THE REGHT TO NOMINATE ONE OF THE FOUR DEPUTY SPEAKERS. THIS WOULD ENTOTE THEM TO CHAIR SOME DEBATES.

### COALHTHON NEGOTHATHONS

8. ATTENTION NOW SWITCHES TO THE COALINTION NEGOTIATIONS ON THE COMPOSITION OF THE NEW CABONET AND ON THE GOVERNMENT'S POLICY PROGRAMME, THE SO-CALLED 'GOVERNMENT DECLARATION'. THESE ARE LINKELY TO BE DIFFORCULT TALKS FOR KOHL. THE FDP, WHO HAD THREE SEATS ON THE LAST CABONET TO THE CDU'S TEN AND THE CSU'S FOR MAY WELL ASK FOR ANOTHER PORTFOLIO AND ONE WHILL BE HARD FOR KOHL TO SAY NO. THEY WILL ALSO WISH TO SEE THE GOVERNMENT'S ECONOMIC AND TAX POLICY ADJUSTED TO THEM LINKING. ON THE CSU SODE, STRAUSS MUST RECOGNISE THAT HIS CHANCES OF A TOP CABONET POST (HINSOFAR AS HIS HINTS THAT HE WANTED ONE WERE EVER MORE THAN BLUFF) HAVE EVAPORATED. BUT HE WILL RESIST PROGROUSLY THE FDP'S EFFORTS TO INCREASE THEM SHARE OF MINISTERMAL OFFICES, AND WHILL PRESS HARD FOR A TOUGHER COALINTION POLICY ON, FOR INSTANCE, LAW AND ORDER. HERE TOO HE WILL CROSS SWORDS AGAIN WITH THE FDP.

9. THE NEW BUNDESTAG INS SCHEDULED TO CONVENE ON 17 FEBRUARY, WHITH THE STATEMENT OF GOVERNMENT POLICY (DEPENDING ON HOW LONG THE NEGOTIHATHONS TAKE) TO FOLLOW IN EARLY MARCH.

1. CDU/CSU/FDP COAL IT ION RETURNED TO POWER, BUT WITH REDUCED MAJORITY. GAINS FOR SMALLER PARTIES. GENSCHER UP, STRAUSS DOWN.

3. THIS RESULT BRINGS THE COU/CSU/FDP COALINTHON BACK TO POWER WHITH A REDUCED MAJORHTY (41 SEATS INSTEAD OF 58). FOR THE COU/CSU THIS IS THE WORST RESULT SHICE 1949, THEHR DROP IN SUPPORT INS A NASTY SURPRISE FOR THEM, ASCRIBED IN INITIAL REACTIONS BY COU LEADERS TO THE LOWER TURN-OUT AND TO UNION VOTERS SWHITCHING TO THE FOR AS A REACTION TO THE CSU'S ATTACKS ON GENSCHER'S FOREIGN POLINCY DURING THE CAMPAIGN. FOR THE SPD THE FEELING IS ONE OF RELIEF THAT THEY DIO NOT DO WORSE. [ PUT THEM WOOSE SINCE 1961]

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BUNDESTAG SEATS

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4. THE WANNERS ARE THE SMALLER PARTIES. BOTH FDP AND GREENS ARE
DELIGHTED WHITH THE RESULT, ALTHOUGH THE GREENS ARE ALSO DISAPPOINTED
THAT THEY DUD NOT OVERTAKE THE FDP AND BECOME THE THURD PARTY IN THE
BUNDESTAG.
