Meanwhile, we shall certainly continue to urge the Turkish side to support the Committee in its efforts to resolve this tragic problem. I urge you to do likewise. We shall also continue to support the United Nations Secretary-General's efforts to find a peaceful, just and lasting settlement in Cyprus, which will be of benefit to all its people.
