CYPRUS

Sir Hugh Rossi, MP asked the Prime Minister's advice on the content of a possible resolution on Cyprus to be proposed by (I think) the Finchley Anglo-Hellenic association.

You might suggest the following elements:

- asks for an all-out effort to end the present tragic division of the island of Cyprus and the creation of a climate of trust in which a peaceful and lasting settlement can be achieved, which respects the unity, sovereignty and independence of Cyprus;
- calls on the Government to work for a justified, federal state in Cyprus in which the two communities may live and work side by side in peace and harmony with full respect for human rights.
