WRITTEN DECLARATION

The EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT

- A - Believing in the right of families to be reunited
B - Confirming its belief in religious freedom
C - Saddened by Russia's failure to adhere to the principles of the Helsinki Agreement
1. Condemns Russia's failure to allow Jewish families to be reunited in Israel
 2. In particular calls for an exit visa to be granted to Mrs Cherna Goldort of Novosibirsk so that she can join her two daughters and five grandchildren in Israel
 3. Urges the Russian Authorities to grant an immediate exit visa to Yana and Yona Reiderman (of Riga) so that they can be united with Yana's husband and Yona's father, Mark, in Israel
 4. Requests an immediate exit visa for Naum Muchnik of Chernovtiskaya Oblast whose close relatives - mother, father and brother - have all lived in Israel since 1980
 5. Calls upon the Soviet Authorities to grant an immediate exit visa to Mr and Mrs Michail Mirvis of Odessa. They first applied for an exit visa in 1979 and Michail's parents have lived in Israel since 1974
 6. Asks for an immediate exit visa for Mr and Mrs Leonid Poliakov of Odessa as Mrs Poliakov's parents and sister have lived in Israel for many years
 7. Urges the Russian Authorities to grant an immediate visa to Mr and Mrs Viktor Yelistratov of Moscow who first applied for an exit visa in 1972; Mrs Yelistratov's three sisters live in Israel
 8. Requests its President to send this declaration to the Secretary General of the United Nations, the Prime Ministers of the Member States and the Secretary General of the Communist Party of the USSR
