Mr CHernyshev, the Soviet Head of Protocol, is the first official the Prime Minister will meet, when he boards the VClO in Moscow on arrival. First Deputy Foreign Minister Kovalev will be in the greeting party. Mr Chernayev is an aide to Gorbachev and will be present at the meetings with the Prime Minister. Metropolitan Yuvenaly will now be the host at Zagorsk and Mr Kharchev will accompany the party on this visit; Mr Saikin, the Mayor of Moscow, will accompany the Prime Minister on her walkabout. Deputy Prime Minister Kamentsev will accompany the Prime Minister at the wreath laying and BSCC office opening in Moscow, and also to Georgia. The Foreign Secretary will also be meeting Deputy Foreign Minister Chaplin and Mr Sepelev in the context of his visit to the Embassy sites. Although the Prime Minister is unlikely to meet them, I enclose notes on them for the sake of completeness. Eight sets of the personality notes and programme are provided. I also enclose for information : - a copy of Moscow tel 483 reporting an exchange of letters today amending the Protocol to our bilateral Air Services Agreements. A reference to this is included in the Foreign Secretary's brief. /a




