As you know, King Olaf is to pay a State Visit to this country from 12-15 April 1988. A formal invitation is to issue from The Queen shortly.

In the light of Nigel Wicks' minute of 29 July to Sir Robert Armstrong we have concluded that President Evren of Turkey should be invited for the Summer State Visit in 1988, which I understand Sir W Heseltine has tentatively scheduled for 12-15 July. If this meets with the Prime Minister's approval we shall now take soundings of the Turks to establish whether President Evren will be able to undertake such a visit at the time suggested.
