Cyprus: Message from the Prime Minister  
to President Kyprianou

President Kyprianou of Cyprus, who suffered a heart attack two weeks ago, arrived in London for tests on 15 December. Our High Commissioner in Cyprus delivered a get-well message, as doyen of the diplomatic corps, shortly after President Kyprianou was taken ill. No further message seemed necessary. Now that he has come to London for tests, however, the Foreign Secretary believes it would be appropriate for the Prime Minister to send a get-well message. I enclose a draft.
