CAPSIS, ALTERNATE FOREIGN MINISTER, ASKED ME TO CALL ON 22 MARCH. HE HAD JUST SEEN PAPANDREOU WHO HAD ASKED ME TO TRANSMIT A MESSAGE FROM HIM TO MRS THATCHER. PAPANDREOU WOULD BE MOST GRATEFUL IF, WHEN SHE SAW OZAL, MRS THATCHER COULD TRY TO PERSUADE HIM TO TAKE TWO STEPS WHICH HE THOUGHT WERE NOW FUNDAMENTAL TO MAKING PROGRESS ON THE CYPRUS ISSUE. 2. THE FIRST WAS THAT OZAL SHOULD MEET VASSILIOU INFORMALLY. PAPANDREOU UNDERSTOOD THAT A FORMAL MEETING WOULD NOT BE POSSIBLE IN PRESENT CIRCUMSTANCES.
