Please accept, Prime Minister, our best wishes and kind regards for you and Mr. Thatcher.

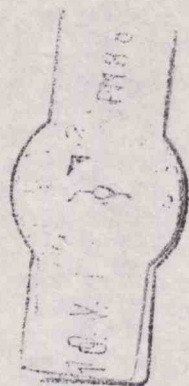
