Cyprus: Possible message to President Vassiliou

Following my letter of 7 July, and as reported in Nicosia telegram no 280 (copy enclosed), the UN Secretary General's Special Representative in Cyprus has now said it would be helpful if we encouraged President Vassiliou urgently not to be too pedantic about the amendments in the draft text which Mr Denktash has proposed and to maintain his agreement to the meeting.

The Foreign Secretary believes that such encouragement is indeed desirable. He recommends that this should be at the highest level and proposes that the Prime Minister should send a personal message to President Vassiliou on the lines of the enclosed draft. If the Prime Minister agrees, we should aim to telegraph the text to Nicosia before the weekend.
