I BELIEVE GEOFFREY AND GEORGE ARE ALREADY IN TOUCH ON THIS. I HOPE THE CRITERIA WE AGREE ON CAN BE AS CLOSE AS POSSIBLE TO THE CRITERIA WHICH THE UNITED STATES GAVE THE SOVIET UNION A YEAR AGO, AND WHICH COVERED PRISONERS OF CONSCIENCE, EMIGRATION, JAMMING AND BILATERAL CASES PLUS THE CREDIBLE GUARANTEES WE SEEK FOR INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF REFORM.
